



 Services (SBS) Subcontractor Certificate
 (for contracts less than \$750K)
- Signed Letter of Assent for compliance with the NYC Design-Build Project Labor Agreement (PLA)



MWBE Prequalification Procedures and Standard Documentation

Prequalification procedures focus on three areas:

- Safety Ability of a contractor to operate safely
 - Experience Modification Rate (EMR)
 - OSHA 300 Logs
 - Safety Plans
 - Certificate of Insurance
- Experience Ability of a contractor to successfully execute the scope of work
 - References
 - Workforce
 - Completed Projects
- Financial Strength Ability of a contractor to finance a project and meet future obligations
 - Financial Statements
 - Surety and Bonding Limits
